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

The **Aleph Champion Program**© is on the cutting edge of Hebrew reading today. Modeled after the Karate/Martial Arts motivational system, it works by dividing different reading skills into levels defined by color. Students understand that their teacher is a black aleph champion and their goal is to reach that level.

Can you imagine children who love reading practice? Aleph Champ time is one of our students' favourite times at Hebrew School! That's because reading is never boring here. The children play games and use new hands-on materials each week to keep Aleph Champ time fun and exciting. One of their highlights is filling up their mini popcorn kernel pots- when it's full, they get to pop them in our popcorn machine! Yum!
